NEWS LETTER

❖ Brief Summary of Cotton Incorporated, Monthly Economic Letter December 2023

In the last month, the cotton prices have stayed mostly the same or slightly decreased. Specifically, the prices for NY/ICE March contracts went between 78 and 82 cents per pound, reaching the highest point at 82 cents on December 7th. The A Index, starting below 90 cents per pound, went up to 92 cents per pound after NY/ICE futures increased. Meanwhile, Chinese prices (CC 3128B) went down from 106 to 103 cents per pound, and Indian spot prices went down from 87 to 85 cents per pound. The USDA report for 2023/24 noted decreases in world production (542,000 bales) and mill use (1.6 million bales). Global ending stocks went up by 900,000 bales, reaching a forecast of 82.4 million bales. Specific to countries, there were production increases for Pakistan and decreases for Mexico, Turkey, and the U.S. Negative mill-use revisions were notable in China, Turkey, and the U.S. Additionally, global trade estimates decreased, with significant changes in imports for China, Bangladesh, Pakistan, and Turkey, as well as exports for Turkey and Brazil. The global production deficit decreased to 811,000 bales, indicating lower demand across supply chains. This reduction suggests that arguments for higher fiber prices might not be as strong. Uncertainties about demand continue, with global mill-use expectations going down from 121.5 million bales to 113.7 million bales since May. Despite losses in various agricultural markets, cotton prices have shown more resilience. The world

balance sheet data for 2023/24 shows a stock/use ratio of 72.5%, indicating a balance in production, use, and stocks. China's balance sheet shows a ratio of 106.1%, while the world-without-China balance sheet has a ratio of 49.4%. Specific to India, the U.S., and Pakistan, their balance sheets indicate different stock/use ratios. Considering the decreasing global production gap and uncertainties about demand, the letter highlights the potential for further reductions in consumption forecasts due to slow downstream demand and challenging spinning margins. While a drop in cotton production has prevented a surplus, a recovery in demand is essential for stable prices. The letter suggests that, along with possible improvements in growing conditions, cotton could see increased acreage and production in 2024/25. In conclusion, the Monthly Economic Letter for December 2023 emphasizes the delicate balance between supply and demand in the global cotton market, focusing on price stability and the potential impact of future developments.
